### TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Entry into the Youth-Adult tournament is open to all current league **YOUTH** members of the **SUNCOAST USBC** only. Adults **DO NOT** have to hold a current USBC membership.
- 2. Youth entrants will use highest Suncoast USBC 2022-2023 Winter/Summer yearbook average of 12 games or more. If no yearbook average youth bowler will use highest current Suncoast USBC 2023-24 season average as of November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Adult bowlers will use highest USBC 2022-2023 Winter/Summer yearbook average of 21 games or more. If no yearbook average adult bowler will use highest current League Average of the 2023-24 season after 15 games. If no current average (as stated above) adult men will use a 160 average, adult women will use a 130 average. The ten (10) pin rule is not in effect for this tournament.
- 3. It will be the responsibility of the respective youth league coach or the adult to furnish all average information to the tournament committee in accordance with Rule 319a (3). PLEASE NOTE: Since it is the responsibility of the youth league coaches to furnish average information for all youth bowlers, it is not necessary to hold the entry forms until the closing date.
- 4. Youth and adult handicap will be based on 90% of 200. Note rules 319a (2) and 319e are waived for this tournament.
- 5. This will be a doubles tournament and entrants may be both male, both female, or mixed. All bowlers will bowl three consecutive games.
- 6. Youth bowlers may enter all squads in this tournament providing they bowl with a different adult partner each time. An adult bowler may bowl with more than one youth at the same time (will bowl three games with each youth) or a different youth each squad.
- 7. Rules not covered herein will be governed by USBC.
- 8. Tournament committee reserves the right to combine divisions if there are less than 5 entries in any one division.
- 9. Schedules will be distributed to bowling center youth directors for posting in their respective bowling centers.
- 10. Lanes and times will be scheduled as entries are received. If no squad time is circled, the tournament committee will schedule to the best interest of the tournament. Squads having less than 10 entries are subject to elimination and entries scheduled to the other squad.
- 11. All teams must report to the bowling center (Maple Lanes Countryside) at least 30 minutes prior to assigned time to bowl. All substitutions must be reported to the tournament committee at least 45 minutes prior to squad time. Late bowlers will be given a 0 for each frame missed.
- 12. Any protest must be made in writing to the tournament committee within twenty-four hours of completion of tournament.
- 13. No refund of entry fee will be made after entry has been processed.
- 14. Youth entrants are not permitted to use any tobacco products or drink alcoholic beverages while in the tournament establishment. Youth entrants are not permitted to play game machines while bowling in the tournament. No food or beverages will be permitted in the bowling circle. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn. Adults, NO ALCOHOLIC Beverages are to be consumed while the tournament is in progress.
- 15. Proper attire is required for both adult and youth bowlers. No halter tops, tank tops, hats, or short shorts will be permitted. No bare midriffs.
- 16. All information pertaining to bowlers requested on the face of this entry form must be furnished, with the exception of the youth average information. Incomplete entries will be returned to sender/applicant within seven days.
